- Minimum 3 years of relevant experience in landscape project management or landscape contracting, including prior arboricultural/horticultural consultancy experience (report writing, site inspections, preservation advice);
- Good command of both English and Chinese (written and spoken);
- Strong management, organisational, communication, and teamwork skills;
- Hard-working, responsible, and independent; and
- Proficient in Microsoft Office.
